- Signing a card is confidential.
- Your employer will never know if you have signed a union membership card.
- Please mail your card in the enclosed postage-paid envelope or call us at 1-866-200-2829 and we'll pick it up.

Fair union dues

We have a fair union dues system.

It's set at 1.85 per cent of gross pay.

For every \$100 in gross pay, \$1.85 goes to dues.

There are no initiation fees.

You don't pay dues on gratuities.

You don't pay union dues until you have voted on and approved your collective agreement.

The rumour mill on Tips and Dues

Forget what the rumours say, as a member of the BCGEU tips will continue to be shared as determined by your tip committees. The BCGEU will not determine your tip pool.

And you only pay union dues on your gross pay-- not on tips!
