LRB asked to revisit ruling

Despite Care Aides voting 43 to 17 in favour of BCGEU representation in November 2006, the Labour Relations Board (LRB) delivered a disappointing decision on June 7, 2007.

The LRB dismissed the BCGEU's application to represent you in collective bargaining. Instead, the LRB concluded that Windsor Manor employees should be in the same bargaining unit with other Advocare employees who work at different locations. The LRB believes a second bargaining unit would lead to industrial instability.

However, the BCGEU disagrees with

the decision and has asked the LRB to reconsider it. The BCGEU believes that a second bargaining unit limited to Windsor Manor will not create industrial instability and reflects your wishes to be represented by the BCGEU instead of CLAC.

The BCGEU realizes that this is a frustrating wait. In the meantime, we wish to thank you for your continued support as we work for you. At the same time, we will continue to keep you informed.
