Care aides vote 43 - 17 in favour of BCGEU representation

Care aides at Windsor Manor have voted 43 – 17 (72 percent) in favour of having the BCGEU represent them.

The vote comes because many of the care aides at Windsor Manor approached the BCGEU asking our union to represent them when dealing with the employer.

The BCGEU already represents LPNs at your worksite.

This is an important day for care aides at Windsor Manor. However, the Christian Labour Association of Canada (CLAC) and AdvoCare (the employer) continue to say that CLAC represents them. Even though

care aides have voted overwhelmingly for the BCGEU, the employer and CLAC may continue to try and argue that CLAC should represent care aides. The vote is significant because it gives weight to the argument that the BCGEU is the clear choice of care aides. The Labour Relations Board has scheduled more hearings on this issue.
